Have a way with words? If you enjoy writing and sharing your thoughts on a topic, then the AMHA Essay Contest is for you! It is easy to enter; just submit your 500 word or less, typed, double-spaced essay on "What was one memorable experience you've had with your AMHA horse?"

1. Participants must be current AMHA Youth Members.
2. Participants must submit a 500 word or less, typed and double-spaced essay on the topic "What affect has the Miniature Horse had on your life."
3. All essays must be written by the youth member, not an adult, and entrants must attest to that fact on the entry form.
4. All winning essays become property of the AMHA and may be reproduced in any manner by AMHA for publication, display or distribution.
5. Multiple submissions are welcome, but a separate entry form must be attached to the back of each essay. Only one entry per participant will be awarded a prize.
6. Entries will not be returned and will become the property of AMHA.
7. Entries will not be accepted after the stated deadline.
8. Awards will be given for first through third place. Honorable mentions will be given.
